NOTICE OF INTENTION TO GRANT A LICENSE

Take Notice that the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities shall on the 7th day of October 2003 (hereafter referred to as the "Grant Date") grant to:

a license to operate as follows:

For the carriage of passengers and their baggage as a scheduled operation from Prince Edward Island to New Brunswick and return with the right to pick up and drop off passengers in the municipalities of Port Elgin, Shediac, Sackville, Moncton, Salisbury, Petitcodiac, Oromocto and Fredericton, but without the right to pick up or drop off en route, using two 15 passenger vans. Any person wishing to object to the granting of this application shall:

1. File with the Board:

- (a) a notice of objection to the application at least 7 days prior to the "Grant Date"; and,
- (b) one day prior to the "Grant Date" a written statement setting out in full the reasons why the application should be denied together with any relevant documentary evidence.

2. Serve a copy of notice of objection upon the applicant by:

- (a) personal service at least 7 days prior to the "Grant Date"; or,
- (b) prepaid registered mail at the address below, posted at least today prior to the "Grant Date"
